## STUDENT PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

Parking in the school lot is a privilege. In order for a student to retain that privilege, he/she must adhere to the following rules and regulations. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action, citation and/or revocation of one's parking privilege.

1. You must be a senior.
2. Each vehicle must be properly registered with school administration.
3. If you lose your parking permit, you must purchase a new tag for \$10.00. You must allow 24-hours before your new tag will be issued.
4. You must hang your parking permit on your rear view mirror so that your permit number can be seen through your windshield.
5. Maximum speed in the parking lot is not to exceed five miles per hour.
6. Drivers must always yield to pedestrians.
7. Once a student has driven into the parking lot, he/she must park his/her vehicle immediately; loitering is impermissible.
8. Students are to park in the designated yellow lined student spaces at the rear of the parking lot. All senior parking space numbers will be preceded by "S", for example S1, S2, and S3 etc. All other parking areas are **OFF LIMITS** to students.
9. During the school day, the parking lot is off limits to students, except during lunch and then, only for seniors who choose to eat lunch off campus.
10. Due to limited space availability, parking permits will be issued to seniors only on a first come, first served basis.
